Chapter 13: 1- 17 Jesus Washes His Disciples' Feet

DAY 1 Obedience and changes...

1. Share an occasion in the past weeks when you acted out of obedience to God.

DAY 2, 3 Read John 13: 1-5

2. (a) Verse 1 Jesus knew that "the time had come". Can you find out all the places in the gospel of John the phrases where "the time/hour has come" or "The time/hour has not come" (or other expressions of the same thing) with the respective chapter and verse #.

(b) What does (a) tell you about the relationship between Jesus and the Father? How do you think you can imitate Christ in this aspect? Can you think of one area of your life that you can do that?

3. (a) What special knowledge does Jesus have regarding himself at this point in time (v.3) ? What was his reaction to this special knowledge, and what insights do you gather about Jesus from this?

(b) In what way can you do the same in your situation?

DAY 4 Read *John 13: 6-11*

4. If you were one of the disciples at the dinner, how would you understand what Jesus was doing, and how would you respond when Jesus came washing your feet?

DAY 5 Read *John 13: 21- 17*

5. Think of one thing/way you can do in obedience to Jesus' words in verse 15 and share it with your class.

6. Share the greatest challenge you faced in the past when you try to apply the lessons in this chapter in your daily life (e.g. work life, family life, school life, church life) and how you are encouraged by what Jesus did in this chapter.
