

## Chapter 13: 18 - 30 Betrayal In the Camp

**DAY 1** Obedience and changes...

1.	Share an occasion in the past weeks when you acted out of obedience to God. (If you can't recall any, is it because you have not been obedient, or you have forgotten your obedience?)
DA	<b>Y 2 to 4</b> Read John 13: 18-21
2.	Find out the OT scriptures Jesus referred to in verse 27. What was Jesus trying to tell the disciples?
3.	(a) Did you experience "He who shares my bread has lifted up his heels against me"? Compare it to the case of Jesus and write down your inspiration.
	(b) What would you do if you knew that your friend or colleague was about to betray you?

•	Jesus had earlier hinted to his disciples that he would be betrayed (write down the verses); now he told them explicitly in verses 21 & 26. How do you understand the openness here and now?
A١	<b>5</b> Read John 13: 22 - 30
•	Read verse 27 in parallel with Matthew 27:3-5. Share your understanding of the phrase "Satan entered into him (Judah)". (e.g was this the cause of Judah's betrayal? Can Satan enter your heart? Since the OT has predicted Judah's betrayal, did God pre-determine that Satan should enter into Judah?)
	The disciples did not stop Judah from betraying Jesus. How do you understand this fact?
	Have you contemplated leaving the Christian faith? What encouragement or reminder do you get from here?
